LOOKING FOR THE LATIN?

Latin is an integral part of our faithful Catholic tradition. Here's where to find the Latin during Mass.

The **LUMEN CHRISTI MISSAL (red book)** is used for the readings and the propers (Antiphons, Responsorial psalm).

If you follow along during the Mass in the **SAINT MICHAEL'S HYMNAL (blue book)** book, you'll be able to find the Latin. Each page spread is set up just so:

- **LATIN** on the **LEFT**
- **ENGLISH** on the **RIGHT**

During **ORDINARY TIME** we will be using the Mass Setting *Missa Jubilate Deo* which begins at #100.

The Pater Noster (Our Father) can always be found on page 86-87.

THIS DAY IN HOLY ROSARY HISTORY

November 1891 - The first Parish Fair is held. Through the years it is recorded under various names: Bazaar, Carnival, Auction, etc. This fete was the largest effort to finance the parish and continued for at least a century.

November 1966 - A baby is found abandoned on the Church Steps. The baby is baptized by Father Maat and named William Joseph. He is taken to the hospital and eventually placed for adoption.
